This "fellowship without walls" has new and exciting changes planned for the 2017-2018 fellowship year. NAPCRG is completing a major update to the website to cover grant development and writing, and also expanding the program to include modules on patient and community engagement, how to determine what's best, developing your knowledge translation plan and making sense of different funder requirements and much more.

The updated program will take a state-of-the-art blended learning approach with only two in person meetings instead of four. You will be able to complete online modules supported by expert mentors at your own pace before each of the in-person sessions that will give you detailed and extensive feedback on your grant application and concept paper.

Postdoctoral Fellowship Division of Behavior & Communication Sciences Department of Clinical Sciences - UT Southwestern Medical Center

A postdoctoral fellowship is available to enhance research capacity in interventional healthcare delivery research, with an emphasis on multiple chronic conditions. Fellowship will provide the successful candidate with opportunity to engage in mentored research. Fellow will gain research experience in recruitment of research participants, primary data collection, integrative data analysis, and implementation science and evaluation.

Sponsored by [Simon Coadock, Lee, PhD, MEd](#), the fellow will join a highly collegial group of faculty investigators, physician scientists, and professional research staff conducting inter-disciplinary team science to alleviate health disparities, especially in urban and rural safety-net settings.

The [University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center](#) is one of the world's leading health science research institutions, with nationally-ranked clinical training programs and a robust commitment to advancing clinical and translational research under the auspices of the NIH-funded [Center for Translational Medicine](#). Unique resources include:

- research database design and programming to support disease
- robust institutional partnerships to facilitate study among insured, under- and uninsured populations

The successful candidate will work with Dr. Lee and faculty colleagues to tailor Fellowship to meet individualized learning needs, further develop research knowledge and skills, and establish their own program of research.

The fellowship offers opportunities for:

- Mentorship and training
- Participation as a co-investigator on multi-disciplinary team science
- Guidance and support in grant writing and budget development
- Development and submission of manuscripts for peer-reviewed publication
- Pedagogic opportunities to provide lectures and/or small group teaching

Terms of the Fellowship
The fellowship is a one-year full-time position, with potential for a second year, subject to performance review. Anticipated start date July 1, 2017 (may be negotiable). Salary will reflect federal NRESA 2017 stipend levels (base: ~\$47,500 + years post-PhD), with benefits.

Eligible Applicants

- Eligible Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:
- The Fellowship is open to US citizens and permanent residents at the time of application.
 - Completion of a PhD or equivalent in public health OR a health research-focused social science within the last 5 years. Students currently enrolled in a doctoral program must provide evidence of deep-in-hand prior to being offered the fellowship.
 - Excellent oral and written communication skills
 - Bilingual English/Spanish language would be an advantage, but is not required.

Application Process

- Initial inquiries should include the following components:
- A cover letter that includes a brief outline of Fellowship goals and relevance to faculty investigator research activities.
 - An up-to-date curriculum vitae noting all peer-reviewed publications and presentations
 - 2-3 academic or professional references available for telephone or email follow-up
