### What is Vimeo?


- Vimeo is the virtual event platform NAPCRG's 2020 Annual Meeting is hosted on.

### How to access the Virtual Annual Meeting:

- Check the email used to register for this year's event for a message from NAPCRG with the subject "NAPCRG Annual Meeting Access Information." Daily handouts will also be emailed each evening to ensure attendees are prepared for the upcoming program.

Create Your Virtual Conference Login

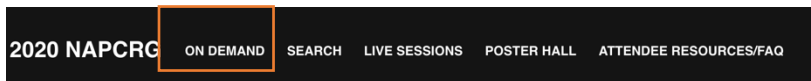
- This will take you to a sign in screen, please go through the steps of setting/resetting a password. Once steps are completed you will have access to our virtual event platform.



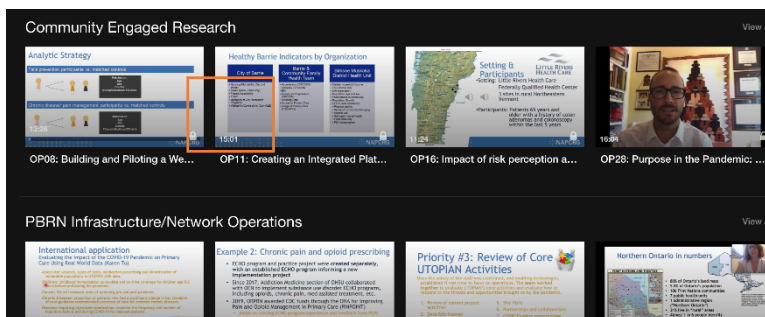
- Be sure to bookmark this conference page on your web browser for easier access throughout the conference dates as well as up to 90 days after the conclusion of the event

**Example 2: Chronic pain and opioid prescribing**

- ECHO program and practice project were created separately, with an established ECHO program informing a new implementation project.
- Since 2017, Addiction Medicine section of OHSU collaborated with OEN to implement substance use disorder ECHO programs, including opioids, chronic pain, and assisted treatment, etc.
- 2019, ORPRN awarded CDC Leads through the OHA for Improving Pain and Opioid Management in Primary Care (PINPOINT)
- Builds on existing ECHO program experience and feedback from PCPs
- Incorporates existing ECHO programs for opioid PR and QI offerings to improve opioid prescribing and chronic pain care

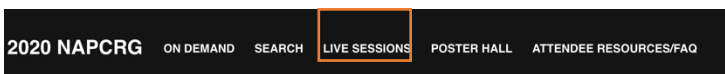

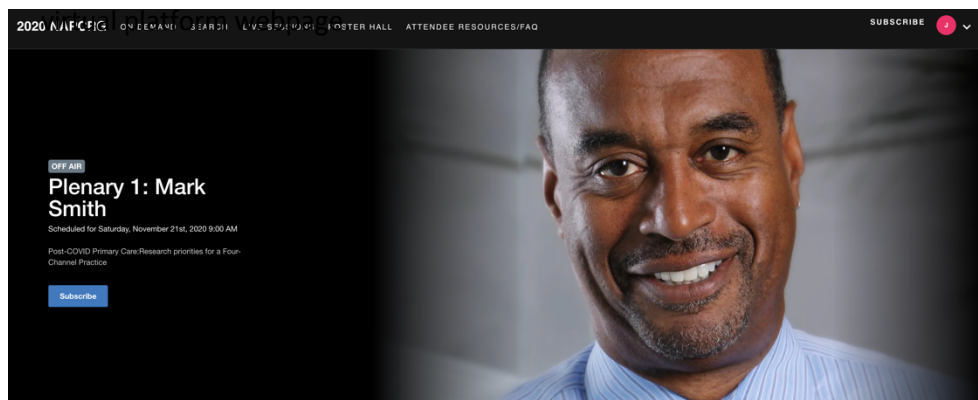


### How do I view a live streamed presentation or panel?

- All current live streamed sessions will be shown on the featured carousel at the top of the



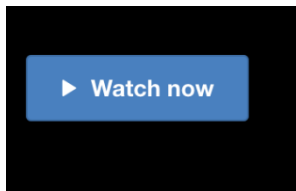
- If “Off Air” is shown the event is upcoming



- If a red “Live” option is shown the event is currently streaming live



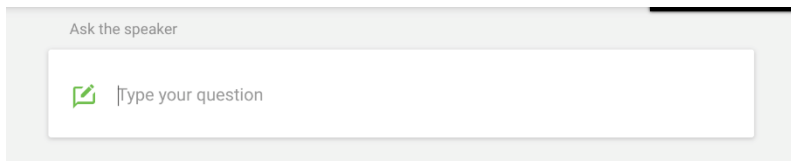
- Click the “Watch Now” to view the current live streamed presentation



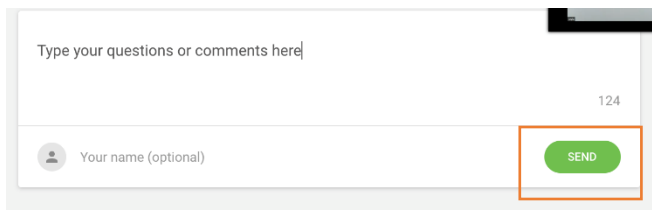
- If live stream session does not beginning right away, please refresh your browser

### How do I ask a question or comment during a live streamed presentation?

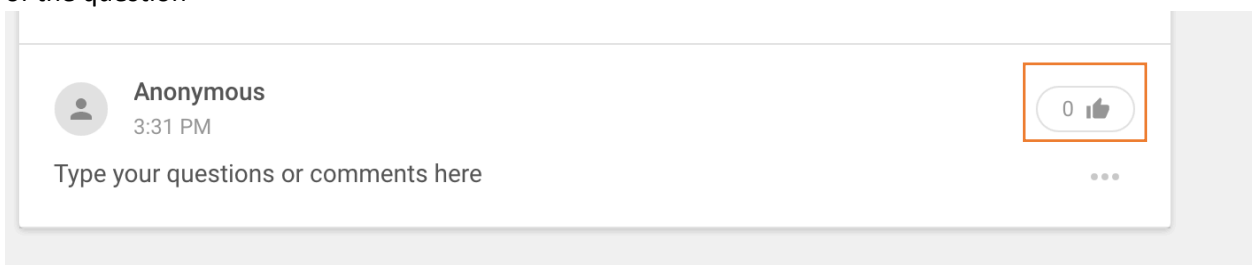
- While viewing the live streamed presentation, scroll down to see the interactive Slido application



- Type in your questions or comments and click “Send”

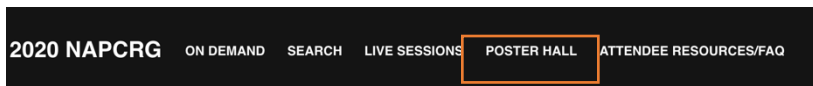


- This will allow fellow attendees to see your questions and comments

## How do I view the Virtual Poster Hall?

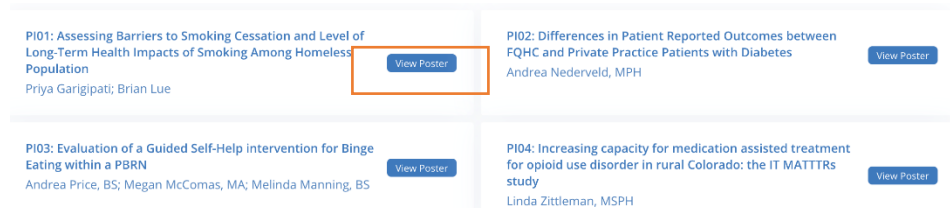
- Click on “Poster Hall” in the top menu bar

## What are the available presentation types for the Annual Meeting?

### **Plenary Presentation, Live Streamed Sessions, and Panel Discussions:**

Are a live stream events with a fixed start and end time. These sessions will be recorded and available for viewing on the Vimeo platform during the conference dates (Nov. 21-24) as well as up to 90 days after the conclusion of the event. These presentations can be found on the Vimeo virtual event Platform.

### **Oral Presentation On-demand Sessions**

These sessions are pre-recorded and may be viewed at your own pace, any time, at your convenience throughout the conference as well as up to 90 days after the conclusion of the event. These videos can be found on the Vimeo virtual event platform.

### **Virtual Poster Hall Poster Presentations**

Posters included in our virtual poster hall may be viewed at your own pace, any time, at your convenience throughout the conference as well as up to 90 days after the conclusion of the event

### **Virtual Poster Walks**

These are interactive sessions where attendees can listen to up to 5 poster presentations live and ask questions to the presenter as well as fellow attendees. The virtual poster walk interactive session are hosted through Zoom.

### **Live Oral Presentations**

These are interactive sessions where attendees can listen to up to 5 oral presentations presented live and ask questions to the presenter as well as fellow attendees. The Live Oral Presentation interactive session are hosted through Zoom.

### **Special Interest Groups (SIG)/Coffee Chat Discussion Rooms**

SIG Rooms on six different topics will be hosted through Zoom on Saturday and Sunday (Nov. 21 & 22). These discussion rooms are open to new and returning SIG members. Don't miss out on the conversation!

### **Will the 2020 Annual Meeting have CME?**
